

St. Peter Garden Committee
Minutes of:
Regular Meeting, July 13, 2015

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Christie Ollerton at 7:10 pm, with a prayer.

In attendance were: Christie Ollerton, Adam Sonnhalter and Vince Farrell.

Because of a lack of a quorum, no business was conducted, however, we did discuss a few items.

Adam advised us that 5 families have planted 48 mounds of pumpkins. The pumpkins should average around 15 lbs each. He is hoping to get a least one more family to participate.

It was suggested that the names of the families be placed on their rows and that weeding and any other necessary work be done at a time of their choosing.

Christie explained that Eddie has been able to do much with the garden due to recent health problems. Hopefully, he'll be back on his feet soon.

Christie advised us that the first row is dedicated to individual plots, row 2 has been planted with sunflowers, and row 3 with cucumbers.

14 kohlrabi plants have been harvested. Andrea Price has agreed to be responsible for one row of tomato plants.

So far, 11 of the 13 rows have been adopted. Cabbage and egg plants have not been adopted. Christies feels that the cabbage is behind development from where it was last year.

Christie will have a "thank you" placed in the church bulletin, thanking Carla Sill for her baking zucchini bread for the July outreach meal.

No decision was made regarding having a table after the Masses on Sunday, since we did not have enough people present to do so.

Vince reminded us that the Garden Committee will be hosting the Donut Sunday on August 2nd.

The following items were on the prepared agenda but were not discussed due to the lack of participation:

Tomatoes need to be staked, Liquid fence update...rain has been a big problem.

Garden looks great with rototilling, Thank you Vince L. and Tom.

Harvesting Sunday plans: email when things start to come in and need help.

Are we doing the Sunday table this year?

Lets hope we have cabbage for coleslaw next month.

Flower garden looks great! Thank you Vince and Kathy Mills for managing it.

Receipts turned in for fill in plants bought and planted by Christie O.for \$34.03, reimbursed 6/22/15.
