Minutes of:

Regular Meeting, April 11, 2015

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jo Ann Tomasheski, with a prayer at 10:01 a.m.

In attendance were: Jo Ann Tomasheski, Fr. Bob, Jackie Madisen, Maggie Finney, Linda Banner, Tom Banner and Vince Farrell.

Jo Ann went over the proposed schedule for 2016 so that we could reserve the Conference Room and other facilities for our activities..

The proposed 2016 schedule is as follows: Women's Luncheon, March 5, 2016, Vacation Blessing, June 3, 2016, Parent's Afternoon Out, December 13, 2016 plus the second Saturday of each month from 9:45 to am to Noon, for our regular meetings.

Father Bob advised is that since we are scheduled to sponsor Donut Sunday this May, that we will not be having donuts on the first Sunday but rather on Pentecost Sunday, which is May 24, 2015.

We will again be baking cookies to distribute after the 5 o'clock Mass on Saturday, May 23rd. An announcement will be placed in the Church bulletin and Siser Pat will be asked to include a flyer in the kids take home packet and an article will be placed on the parish web site.

Father Bob and Jo Ann will design a holy card to be placed in the plastic baggies with the cookies.

Jo Ann has balloons left over from last year and will purchase a new helium tank to inflate same. We have up to \$130.00 to spend on the event.
